2	<u>GRAMMAR:</u> Present perfect, defining relative clauses <u>VOCABULARY:</u> relationships, life choices <u>COMPETENCES/COMMUNICATION:</u> Talk about relationships, duration of ongoing situations, give defining information, discussing choices
3	<u>GRAMMAR:</u> Verb + -ing VS verb + infinitive, past continuous, past continuous VS past simple <u>VOCABULARY:</u> Holidays and holiday activities, travel and tourism <u>COMPETENCES/COMMUNICATION:</u> talk about holidays, responsible tourism, holidays stories, asking and giving directions
4	<u>GRAMMAR:</u> will/won't/may/might, must/mustn't, have to/don't have to <u>VOCABULARY:</u> the climate and extreme weather, the weather, climate action <u>COMPETENCES/COMMUNICATION:</u> Talk about climate and weather, probability, obligation and prohibition, asking for, giving and refusing permission
5	<u>GRAMMAR:</u> Passive: present and past simple, passive: interrogative form, subject/object questions <u>VOCABULARY:</u> TV and film genres, describing films, screen time <u>COMPETENCE/COMMUNICATION:</u> talk about TV series, watching films, screen trivia, discussing films
6	<u>GRAMMAR:</u> Present perfect continuous, present perfect simple VS p.p. continuous <u>VOCABULARY:</u> jobs, describing jobs, looking for work <u>COMPETENCE/COMMUNICATION:</u> Talk about jobs, duration of ongoing situations, ongoing actions and situations, having an interview
7	<u>GRAMMAR:</u> Modals of deduction: present and past <u>VOCABULARY:</u> Crimes and criminals, criminal investigation <u>COMPETENCE/COMMUNICATION:</u> Talk about crime, cybercrime, crime mysteries
8	<u>GRAMMAR:</u> Second conditional; wish + past simple; past perfect <u>VOCABULARY:</u> stories; Story words; adjectives with -ed and -ing <u>COMPETENCE/COMMUNICATION:</u> talking about a book
